

Framingham Democratic Committee
RESOLUTION
An Act Relative to Work and Family Mobility
Adopted July 19, 2020

WHEREAS, The Framingham Democratic Committee has tracked, discussed, debated and supported legislation which impacts the allowance of undocumented immigrants to attain licenses to operate motor vehicles in Massachusetts for over a decade;

WHEREAS, the Massachusetts Legislature has introduced numerous bills in both chambers over the years, and none have successfully been enacted as of this date;

WHEREAS, there has been a bill introduced by Representatives Tricia Farley-Bouvier and Christine Barber in the House of Representatives, titled An Act Relative to Work and Family Mobility, Bill H.3012;

WHEREAS, there has been a bill introduced by the Joint Committee on Transportation, also titled An Act Relative to Work and Family Mobility, and now pending before the Senate, Bill S.2641, now pending before the Senate Committee on Ways and Means;

WHEREAS, at its meeting held remotely on July 19, 2020, the Framingham Democratic Committee was addressed by Pablo Ruiz, a member of the Massachusetts State Democratic Committee with an appeal to support the above legislation;

WHEREAS, upon motion and discussion it was voted that the Framingham Democratic Committee take action to support this legislation.


NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED: The Framingham Democratic Committee supports the enactment of legislation mandating drivers' licenses for undocumented immigrants as it is discussed in House Bill 3012 and Senate Bill 2641 and directs the Chair to sign and deliver a copy of this **RESOLUTION** to the Senate President, the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the entire Framingham Delegation.
