Councilor Tracey Bryant Endorsed by The Framingham Democratic Committee

Framingham, MA (October 31, 2023) - At a special meeting on October 5, 2023, the Framingham Democratic Committee (FDC) voted unanimously to endorse Tracey Bryant in her re-election campaign for Framingham District 9 City Councilor.
